E.E.H.S. SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES

<u>Policy:</u> As a memorial to the Founders, Teachers, and Students of East End High School (1953-1969), the East End High School Alumni Association has established a Scholarship to be awarded to a student who meets the criteria of the Scholarship Committee.

<u>Objectives:</u> The objectives for awarding these scholarships are to encourage:

- a. Persons to further their training after high school.
- b. Assist persons in need of financial aid.

<u>Guidelines:</u> 1. The Scholarship application be obtained from the committee.

- 2. The Scholarship Committee or Designee screen applications and make recommendations of recipients for scholarship.
- 3. The scholarship be paid to the student at the beginning of his or her enrollment in an institution of higher learning.

Requirements:

- 1. Exhibit scholastic proficiency, exemplify moral standards, project a wholesome personality, demonstrate qualities of leadership consistent with the aims of the E.E.H.S. Alumni Association.
- 2. Have been accepted by an accredited institution of higher learning and plan to enroll.
- 3. Complete an application form and submit to the Committee on or before July 15th of the year entering the institution of higher learning.
- 4. Secure written recommendations from two persons attesting to his or her characteristics of integrity, conscientiousness and leadership ability. (These persons must include the Counselor or Principal of his or her high school and a respectable citizen of the community.)
- 5. Should be a descendant of a member of the East End High School.
- 6. Can reapply if the course is successfully completed but preference will be given to the first-time applicants.

Note: STUDENTS MUST QUALIFY IN TERMS OF BOTH, ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY AND FINANCIAL NEEDS.
